

KDRAC Policies

Property Care and Removal - Members, their dependents, or guests must not damage camp property. Depending on the discretion of the Camp Management, charges may apply for any damaged or broken property, up to twice the replacement value. Camp property should not be taken off the premises without prior permission from the Management.

Conduct - Members, their dependents, and guests are expected to uphold a courteous and respectful demeanor while on camp premises.

Prohibited Activities - The camp reserves the right to prohibit any games, sports, or activities it deems detrimental to the overall membership or camp interests.

Right of Access - The camp's staff may need to access the Member's or guest's accommodation if there is an unforeseen problem, to investigate an incident if needed, or to perform certain routine property checks. If this happens, the Camp Management will do its best to let the Member or the guest(s) know in advance of the date and time that access will be needed.

Responsibility - Every Member bears the complete responsibility for any harm or damage inflicted on camp property by themselves, their dependents, or guests. Additionally, any unpaid bills, charges, or debts incurred by a Member's dependents or guests within the camp premises shall be the Member's accountability.

Firearms and Weapons - Carrying firearms is strictly limited to authorized security personnel, bodyguards of dignitaries, and individuals sanctioned by the Camp Management. Carrying firearms or weapons by Members is prohibited under Republic Act No. 1866, as amended. Violation of this rule may result in membership suspension or expulsion.

Noise Management - All Members and guests are kindly requested to maintain a considerate noise level within the camp premises. Playing radios, recorders, TV sets, and similar electronic devices that may produce sound disturbance are restricted from the camp's main facilities and public spaces, unless they are operated using earphones. Exceptions to this rule require prior permission from the Operations Manager.

Ensuring Safety - While every effort is made to ensure the safety of individuals within the camp premises, it's important to note that the camp does not bear responsibility for personal safety or property belonging to Members, their dependents, and guests. However, the Management takes measures to safeguard personal belongings left in designated areas as specified.

Smoking - Smoking is strictly prohibited within the camp premises.

Prohibition of Drugs - All prohibited drugs are not allowed within the camp premises.

Gambling - Gambling activities are strictly prohibited within the camp premises.

Appropriate Attire - All Members must adhere to proper attire guidelines based on specific camp areas, including Lobby Areas, Function Rooms, Restaurants and Cafes, and other Sports and Recreation Facilities.
